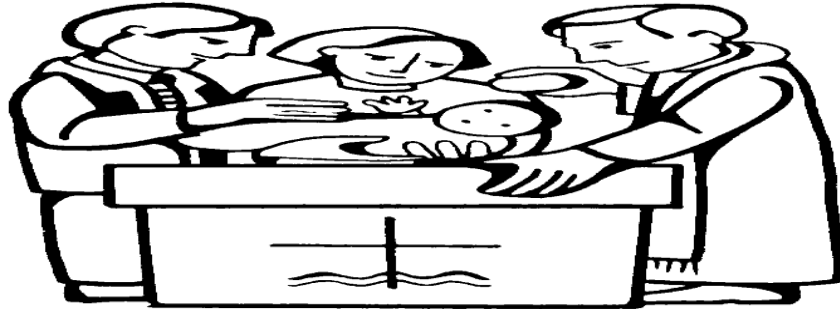


Welcome to St George's Church
