**Manx Pilgrimage:** A 36-mile (60km) hike will take place over the four-day bank holiday weekend (27-30 August) along the Triskelion Way, a pilgrimage trail created in 2016. The route crosses the island through superb coast and hill scenery, linking the historic centres of Rushen Abbey, Peel Cathedral and Maughold. Anyone is welcome, for just half a day or the full four. No charge is made. Ancient sites will be visited along the way, including keeills (early chapels), carved crosses and a holy well. In a spirit of pilgrimage, the event offers a chance to take time out for reflection, poetry, prayer and silence.
