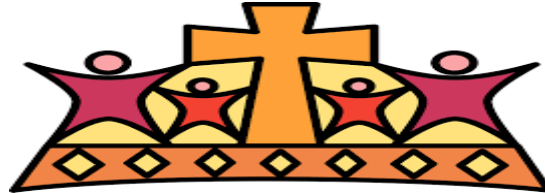


*Welcome to St George's Church*
